Any such adjustment services contract must contain a provision, prominently printed on the first page of the contract, stating that the person contracting with the adjuster has the option to rescind the contract within $2 4$ business days after the contract is signed.'
25	SUMMARY
26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33	This amendment replaces the bill and is the minority report of the committee. Current law prohibits a public insurance adjuster from soliciting or offering an adjustment services contract to any person for at least 36 hours after an accident or occurrence as a result of which the person might have a potential claim. This amendment removes that prohibition and instead provides that public insurance adjusters may not solicit or offer a contract during an accident or occurrence. The amendment also extends the time in which a person may rescind an adjustment services contract from 2 to 4 business days after the contract is signed.
