21 22 23 24 25	The bill, as amended by Committee Amendment "A," requires that temporary signs placed in the public right-of-way be marked with the date that the sign was erected. This amendment removes that requirement and eliminates the requirement in current law that such temporary signs be labeled with the designated time period that the sign will be maintained.
