1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	<b>Sec. 1. 4 MRSA §1059, sub-§3,</b> as enacted by PL 2009, c. 417, §1, is repealed.
3	SUMMARY
4	This bill removes the provision of law that repeals the laws that direct fines derived
5	from tribal law enforcement activities to the Passamaquoddy Tribe and the Penobscot
