24 25 26 27 28	Under the current rules of the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources, Board of Pesticides Control, commercial pesticide applicators are required to notify an individual listed on the Maine Pesticide Notification Registry when performing an outdoor, nonagricultural pesticide application.

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2 3 4	This amendment requires the board to amend its rules to require, instead of the commercial applicator, the landowner, lessee or other legal occupant of property who initiates a pesticide application to provide notification of the pesticide application.
