In developing this plan, the department shall consider, at a minimum, the ecological and economic impacts of proposed methods of controlling mosquitoes and preventing their breeding. These proposed methods must include integrated pest management techniques and other science-based technology that minimizes the risks of pesticide use to humans and the environment. The department shall include in the plan the criteria for declaring a mosquito-borne disease public health threat, the elements of a response to such a threat and a description of the lines of authority and responsibilities during a public health threat; and be it further

Resolved: That the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry shall report on its plan for protecting the public health from mosquito-borne diseases to the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry by December 15, 2013. The Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry may report out a bill on the plan for the protection of the public health from mosquito-borne diseases to the Second Regular Session of the 126th Legislature.

1	SUMMARY
2	This amendment is the unanimous report of the Joint Standing Committee or
3	Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry. It replaces the bill with a resolve that directs the
4	Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry to develop a plan for the
5	protection of the public health from mosquito-borne diseases, in cooperation with
6	appropriate personnel from the Department of Health and Human Services. The resolve
7	also requires that the department report on its plan to the Joint Standing Committee or
8	Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry by December 15, 2013 and authorizes the
