3. Plan required. Beginning in calendar year 2000 2018, the commissioner shall by May 1st of each year present a plan for expenditures from the fund for the next fiscal year to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over marine resource matters. When developing the plan, the commissioner shall consult with harvesters and seaweed dealers the Seaweed Advisory Council established in Title 5, section 12004-I, subsection 57-H.

Sec. 4. Staggered terms. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 6087, subsection 3, of the initial appointments of the Seaweed Advisory Council, the Commissioner of Marine Resources shall designate the first 2 appointments for 2-year terms and the next 3 appointments for 3-year terms. An initial term of 2 years may not be considered a full term for purposes of limiting the number of terms for which a member may serve.

13 SUMMARY

 This bill establishes the Seaweed Advisory Council to advise the Commissioner of Marine Resources and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over marine resources matters on matters of interest to the State's seaweed industry.
