1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §1125, sub-§6-F is enacted to read:
3 4 5	<b>6-F.</b> Participation in political action committees. A certified candidate may not establish a political action committee for which the certified candidate is a principal officer, fund-raiser or decision maker.
6	SUMMARY
7	This bill prohibits a certified candidate under the Maine Clean Election Act from
8	establishing a political action committee for which the candidate is a principal officer,
9	fund-raiser or decision maker.
