**Sec. 1. Acquisition of easement for access to Dead River. Resolved:** That the Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Lands shall acquire a public right-of-way approximately 16 miles in length along the Lower Enchanted Road, from Route 201 in West Forks Plantation westward to and including an area commonly used for vehicle parking, trip staging and watercraft access to the Dead River near its confluence with Spencer Stream.

7 SUMMARY

 This resolve directs the Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Lands to acquire a public right-of-way approximately 16 miles in length along the Lower Enchanted Road, from Route 201 in West Forks Plantation westward to and including an area commonly used for vehicle parking, trip staging and watercraft access to the Dead River near its confluence with Spencer Stream.
