An Act To Require Edible Landscaping in a Portion of Capitol Park

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §902, sub-§1-B is enacted to read:
3	1-B. Edible landscaping. The commission shall arrange for and oversee the
4	development and maintenance of edible landscaping in a portion of Capitol Park.
5	Development of edible landscaping is subject to available funding. The commission may
6	seek and accept funds from private and public sources for the development and
7	maintenance of the edible landscaping portion of Capitol Park.
8	SUMMARY
9	This bill requires edible landscaping in a portion of Capitol Park. The development of
10	the edible landscaping portion of Capitol Park is subject to available funding, and the
11	State House and Capitol Park Commission may seek and accept public and private funds
12	for this purpose.
