22 23 24 25 26 27 28	This amendment refines the provision in Part C of the bill to clarify that career and technical education regions may be eligible for reimbursement for adult career and technical education courses and adult workforce training and retraining courses. The amendment clarifies that career and technical education regions must meet the accountability requirements described in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 8601-A, subsection 1, including the use of the adult education intake form and the adult education data management system.
