1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §1100-B, sub-§3, ¶B, as amended by PL 2009, c. 227, §3, is
3	further amended to read:
4	B. The fitting of a denture to an edentulous or partially edentulous arch or arches,
5	including the making, producing, reproducing, constructing, finishing, supplying,
6	altering and repairing of dentures, without performing alteration to natural or
7	reconstructed tooth structure. Upon the receipt of a written statement of oral
8	condition or oral health certificate as determined by the board by a licensed dentist, a
9	A denturist may complete perform clinical procedures related to the fabrication of a
10	removable tooth-borne partial denture, including cast frameworks; and
11	SUMMARY
12	This bill removes the requirement that a denturist first receive a written statement of
13	oral condition or oral health certificate prior to making partial dentures.
