- 1 Sec. 1. Franco-American monument. Resolved: That the Capitol Planning 2 Commission shall construct and maintain a monument in honor of men and women of 3 Franco-American heritage in the State, in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, 4 Title 5, chapter 14-A; and be it further
- 5 Sec. 2. Funding assistance. Resolved: That the Capitol Planning Commission 6 may accept state and local funds, gifts and other contributions to be used solely to carry 7 out the purposes of this resolve.
- 8 SUMMARY
- 9 This resolve directs the Capitol Planning Commission to raise and maintain a 10 monument to men and women of Franco-American heritage in the State. It also allows 11 the commission to accept gifts and private contributions to assist in achieving this goal.
