COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " " to H.P. 419, L.D. 536, Bill, "An Act To Help Deter Youth Smoking and To Help Smokers Quit"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 5 and inserting the following:
'Sec. 5. $\mathbf{3 6}$ MRSA $\S 4381$ is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

## \$4381. Disposition of revenue

The revenue derived from the tax imposed by this chapter and described in section 4365-G must be distributed as follows:

1. General Fund. One hundred mills per cigarette must be deposited to the General Fund;
2. Fund for a Healthy Maine. Twenty-five mills per cigarette must be deposited in the Fund for a Healthy Maine;
3. Tax Relief Fund for Maine Residents. Twenty-five mills per cigarette must be deposited in the Tax Relief Fund for Maine Residents established in Title 5, section 1518-A; and
4. Nursing facilities fund. Twenty-five mills per cigarette must be deposited in the nursing facilities fund account in the Department of Health and Human Services.

Sec. 6. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.
