18 19	2. Fund for a Healthy Maine. Twenty-five mills per cigarette must be deposited in the Fund for a Healthy Maine;
20 21 22	3. Tax Relief Fund for Maine Residents. Twenty-five mills per cigarette must be deposited in the Tax Relief Fund for Maine Residents established in Title 5, section 1518-A; and
