### An Act To Create an Apprentice Trapper License

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §12204 is enacted to read:
3	<u>§12204. Apprentice trapper license</u>
4 5	<b>1. Definitions.</b> As used in this section, unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.
6 7	<u>A.</u> "In the presence of" means in visual and voice contact without the use of visual or audio enhancement devices, including binoculars and citizen band radios.
8 9 10	B. "Supervisor" means a person who is 18 years of age or older, has held a valid trapping license under this subchapter for 3 consecutive years and is trapping with a person holding an apprentice trapper license.
11 12	<b>2.</b> Supervisor required. A holder of an apprentice trapper license may not trap other than in the presence of a supervisor.
13 14 15 16	3. Supervisor responsibility. A supervisor shall ensure that the holder of an apprentice trapper license follows safe and ethical trapping protocol and adheres to the laws under this Part. A supervisor may not intentionally permit a person trapping under an apprentice trapper license with that supervisor to violate subsection 2.
17 18 19 20 21 22 23	<b>4.</b> Eligibility. A resident or nonresident 16 years of age or older who has never held a valid trapping license or junior trapping license in this State, or any other state, province or country, is eligible to obtain an apprentice trapper license, except that a person may not be issued an apprentice trapper license after having previously held an apprentice trapper license under this section. A person is eligible to obtain an apprentice trapper education course as described in section 10108, subsection 7.
24 25	<b>5. Expiration of apprentice trapper license.</b> An apprentice trapper license is valid for up to 12 calendar months and expires on June 30th.
26 27 28	<b>6. Issuance; fee.</b> The commissioner, through the commissioner's authorized agent, shall issue an apprentice trapper license to an eligible person. The fee for an apprentice trapper license is \$35 for residents and \$317 for nonresidents.
29 30	<b>7. Restrictions.</b> The holder of an apprentice trapper license is not eligible to obtain a permit to trap for bear under section 12260-A.
31	<b>8. Penalties.</b> The following penalties apply to violations of this section.
32 33	A. A person who violates this section commits a civil violation for which a fine of not less than \$100 and not more than \$500 may be adjudged.
34 35 36	B. A person who violates this section after having been adjudicated as having committed 3 or more civil violations under this Part within the previous 5-year period commits a Class E crime.

#### SUMMARY

This bill creates an apprentice trapper license. An apprentice trapper license allows a person who has never held a trapping license to go trapping with an experienced trapper for up to one year without having to take a trapper education course. The holder of an apprentice trapper license must, while trapping, be under the direct supervision of an experienced trapper at all times. An apprentice trapper license allows a person to trap for all species that may be legally trapped, except black bear. The fee for an apprentice trapper license is the same as for a regular trapping license.
