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SUMMARY

2 This amendment is the majority report of the committee. It specifies that the Department of Health and Human Services must hire 5 new state-certified health 3 inspectors, instead of a sufficient number of inspectors as proposed in the resolve, and 4 clarifies that the additional inspectors are to be hired for the purpose of inspecting each 5 licensed establishment in this State pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, 6 7 section 2497. The amendment keeps the requirement that directs the department to report 8 to the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services regarding the cost of the new health inspectors and adds a requirement that the department report on whether it is 9 meeting the inspection requirements of Title 22, section 2497. The amendment also adds 10 an appropriations and allocations section. 11
