1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §4572-A, sub-§6 is enacted to read:
3 4 5 6	6. Employee with nursing child. It is unlawful employment discrimination in violation of this Act, except where based on a bona fide occupational qualification, for an employer to fail to provide to an employee with a nursing child the accommodations required under Title 26, section 604.
7	SUMMARY
8 9 10	This bill provides that it is unlawful employment discrimination under the Maine Human Rights Act for an employer to fail to provide certain workplace accommodations for an employee with a nursing child.
