16 17 18 19	Sec. 2. Task force membership. Resolved: That the task force consists of 11 members, one of whom is the Executive Director of the Maine Milk Commission. The Executive Director of the Maine Milk Commission shall invite the following to participate as members of the task force:
20	1. The Executive Director of the Maine Dairy Industry Association;
21	2. One representative of a large milk processor;
22 23	3. One representative of a small milk processor, giving preference to an organic milk processor;
