SUMMARY

This amendment provides that, for fiscal year 2015-16 and beyond, in the event a municipality is approved for an adjustment to its state property valuation due to a sudden and severe disruption in its municipal valuation, that adjusted state valuation is the property fiscal capacity for purposes of determining municipal contributions under the school funding formula.

This amendment also establishes adjustments to state valuations for the towns of Madison, Skowhegan, East Millinocket and Jay for the purposes of state-municipal
