9 10 11	D. Do all in the commissioner's power to awaken and sustain an interest in education among the people and to stimulate school officers, teachers and other educational personnel to well directed efforts in their work-; and
12	Sec. 3. 20-A MRSA §255, sub-§5, ¶E is enacted to read:
13 14 15 16 17 18	E. Annually post on the department's publicly accessible website statewide historical financial data on the State's education funding. The data must be organized to allow for ease and consistency in comparing categories from year to year for a period of no less than 10 years and must include appropriate annotations to reflect changes in calculation methodology and statute or other anomalies affecting comparative outcomes.

20 21 22	This bill directs the Commissioner of Education to annually post on the Department of Education's publicly accessible website statewide historical financial data on education funding for a period of no less than 10 years.
