An exemption from the licensure requirements under this Article does not apply if the individual, alone or with others, is found by the administrator to have acted so as to intentionally circumvent or evade the provisions of this subsection.'

20 21 22 23	This amendment provides that an individual must be licensed as a mortgage loar originator if that individual negotiates mortgage terms more than 3 times within a 12-month period or a fewer number of times if the Superintendent of Consumer Credi Protection finds intent to circumvent or evade licensing requirements.
