#### An Act To Amend the Identification Requirements under the Maine Medical Use of Marijuana Act

#### 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §2425, sub-§5, as amended by PL 2009, c. 631, §32 and 3 affected by §51, is further amended to read:

4 5. Registry identification card issuance. The department shall issue registry identification cards to registered patients, to registered primary caregivers and to staff of 5 hospice providers and nursing facilities named as primary caregivers within 5 days of 6 approving an application or renewal under this section. Registry identification cards 7 8 expire one year after the date of issuance except that the date of issuance and expiration date of a registered primary caregiver's registry identification card must be the same as 9 10 the issuance and expiration dates on the patient's registry identification card. Registry identification cards must contain: 11

- 12 A. The name, address and date of birth of the patient cardholder;
- B. The name, address and date of birth of each registered primary caregiver, if any,
  of the patient;
- 15 C. The date of issuance and expiration date of the registry identification card;
- 16 D. A random identification number that is unique to the cardholder; and
- 17 E. A photograph, if required by the department; and
- F. For a registered primary caregiver, a <u>A</u> clear designation showing whether the cardholder is allowed under this chapter to cultivate marijuana plants for the patient's medical use.
- 21 Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §2425, sub-§11 is enacted to read:

11. Valid identification. A registered patient, registered primary caregiver or a
 principal officer, board member or employee of a registered dispensary who has been
 issued a valid registry identification card pursuant to this section must also possess a valid
 Maine-issued driver's license with a photo or other Maine-issued photo identification in
 order to establish proof of authorized participation in the medical use of marijuana under
 this chapter.

# SUMMARY This bill clarifies that an individual must posses both a valid registry identification card and a valid Maine-issued driver's license or other Maine-issued photo identification as proof of valid participation in the medical use of marijuana. This bill specifies that a primary caregiver's registry identification card expires on the

- 33 same date that the patient's card expires.
- 34 This bill removes the requirement that registry identification cards contain 35 information distinguishing the cardholder as a patient or primary caregiver and a photo.
