This resolve directs the Department of Health and Human Services to amend its Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits Manual to permit neuropsychological testing assistants, 9 10 also known as psychometricians, to administer and score neuropsychological and 11 psychological tests of MaineCare patients under the supervision of a licensed 12 psychologist. 13
