An Act To Increase the Fee Paid to a Funeral Home To Transport a Body at the Request of the State Medical Examiner

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3024, 4th ¶, as amended by PL 2001, c. 222, §3, is further
amended to read:

The Chief Medical Examiner may authorize any other expenses necessary to carry out the Chief Medical Examiner's duties. <u>The Chief Medical Examiner shall reimburse a</u> funeral establishment that transports a body to Augusta at the request of the Office of <u>Chief Medical Examiner at the following rates: for up to and including the first 25 miles,</u> <u>\$120; for the next 25 miles, \$2 per mile traveled while actually transporting a body; and</u> for miles in excess of 50, \$1.75 per mile traveled while actually transporting a body.
