1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §13072, sub-§11 is enacted to read: 3 11. Provide municipal assistance for job training and projects. The director shall establish and monitor a program to promote economic growth and development by using 4 grants to be matched one-to-one by funds from a municipality for economic development 5 through on-the-job training for people receiving general assistance who are in need of 6 training or retraining for jobs that are at risk in projects that retain employment in that 7 municipality. The funds must be used to: 8 9 A. Provide on-the-job training for workers of a local employer or business in 10 partnership with the municipality; B. Provide training for workers through the Maine Community College System in 11 partnership with the municipality; and 12 13 C.
