2	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1751, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:
3	1-A. Exception; new motor vehicles. Notwithstanding subsection 1 and except for
4	a commercial motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer, a new motor vehicle that has had an
5	inspection under this section is not required to have another inspection until 2 years from
6	the last day of the month in which it was initially registered. For purposes of this
7	subsection, "new motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle that has not been previously titled
8	and registered.
9	SUMMARY
10	This bill provides that a new motor vehicle, except a commercial motor vehicle,
11	trailer or semitrailer, that has had an inspection is not required to have another inspection
12	until 2 years from the last day of the month in which it was initially registered.
