2	Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §3015 is enacted to read:
3	§3015. Regulation of employee wages and benefits
4 5 6 7	A municipality may not enact or enforce an ordinance, regulation or order regulating a wage or benefit of an employee provided by an employer except for an ordinance concerning a life safety matter or establishing a minimum wage rate for a particular class of workers during a particular period of time.
