the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over housing matters. 1 The report must include a summary of any meetings that occur pursuant to section 1, a 2 list of participants in the examination of fair chance housing policies, suggestions to 3 increase the awareness among housing providers of the challenges faced by formerly 4 incarcerated individuals in finding housing and any other relevant information. The report 5 may include suggested legislation. The joint standing committee of the Legislature 6 having jurisdiction over housing matters may report out legislation to the First Regular 7 Session of the 130th Legislature based on the report.' 8

## SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill with a resolve that directs the Maine State Housing 10 Authority in collaboration with stakeholders to examine fair chance housing policies 11 considered or adopted in other jurisdictions to evaluate options for the State to adopt that 12 would address housing issues and expand housing opportunities for formerly incarcerated 13 individuals without placing an excessive burden on housing providers. It requires the 14 authority to submit a report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having 15 jurisdiction over housing matters that includes findings and recommendations and 16 includes a summary of any meetings that occur regarding the examination, a list of 17 participants in the examination, suggestions to increase the awareness among housing 18 providers of the challenges faced by formerly incarcerated individuals in finding housing 19 and any other relevant information. It allows the authority to include suggested 20 legislation in its report. Lastly, it allows the joint standing committee of the Legislature 21 having jurisdiction over housing matters to report out legislation based on the report. 22
