An Act To Change the Definition of "Hard Cider" for Consistency with Federal Law

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- **Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §2, sub-§12-A,** as amended by PL 2009, c. 652, Pt. A, §41, is further amended to read:
- **12-A. Hard cider.** "Hard cider" means liquor produced by fermentation of the juice of apples <u>or pears</u>, including, but not limited to, flavored, sparkling or carbonated cider, that contains not less than 1/2 of 1% alcohol by volume and not more than 7% 8.5% alcohol by volume.
 - **Sec. 2. Effective date.** This Act takes effect January 1, 2017.
