Money in the fund may be used only for eradication of invasive aquatic plant and nuisance species. Eradication does not include containing, monitoring or inspecting invasive aquatic plant and nuisance species. The fund may be used to provide grants to municipalities or other entities for eradication programs to protect the inland waters of the State from invasive aquatic plant and nuisance species.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the State Controller shall transfer \$246,650, to the extent available, from the Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Carrying Account, General Fund account within the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to the Eradication of Invasive Aquatic Plant and Nuisance Species Fund established in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 38, section 1866 by July 10, 2014.
