4	Commission shall submit a report regarding the review under section 1 to the Joint
5	Standing Committee on Judiciary an interim report regarding the review under section 1
6	no later than December 1, 2013 and submit a final report, together with any necessary
7	implementing legislation, to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having
8	jurisdiction over judiciary matters no later than December 15, 2014. The Joint Standing
9	Committee on Judiciary joint standing committee is authorized to report out a bill based
10	on the <u>final</u> report to the <u>Second First</u> Regular Session of the <u>126th</u> <u>127th</u> Legislature.

12	Sec. 2. Retroactivity. Resolved: That this resolve applies retroactively to
13	December 1, 2013.
14	SUMMARY
15	This resolve extends the date for the Probate and Trust Law Advisory Commission to
16	issue its final report on the inheritance of digital assets to December 15, 2014. Resolve
17	2013, chapter 27 established the commission's duty to conduct a review and set a
18	reporting date of December 1, 2013. The commission submitted an interim report before
19	the original reporting date of December 1, 2013.
