14	This amendment:

Clarifies that agents authorized by the Secretary of State to issue noncommercial driver's license renewals and nondriver identification card renewals may issue duplicates of noncommercial driver's license renewals but not duplicates of nondriver identification card renewals as stated in the bill;
19 20 21	2. Authorizes the Secretary of State to issue an agriculture education plate in another sequence in addition to a 3-number and 3-letter sequence at the discretion of the Secretary of State;
22 23 24	3. Authorizes the Secretary of State to issue unassigned temporary registration permits to a licensed auction business when the licensed auction business sells a vehicle to a dealer;
25 26 27	4. Allows a vehicle to be sold at a licensed dealer auction to a licensed dealer prior to the dealer's possessing the title and clarifies that the licensed dealer may take possession of the vehicle;
28 29	5. Removes the provision that to qualify for a dealer license an applicant must maintain a repair department for the repair of 2 vehicles simultaneously;
30 31	6. Allows a motor vehicle rental company to be issued transporter plates and a license to transport a vehicle owned by or in the custody of that business or its owner;
32 33 34	7. Clarifies that a person under 18 years of age who has been issued a driver's license may not use a handheld electronic device while operating a motor vehicle, whether or not that person has an intermediate license;
