An Act To Update Statutory Dates for the State Government Evaluation Act Review of Agencies

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12 The joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and 13 local government matters shall review the provisions and effects of this chapter no later 14 than June 30, 2000 2012 and at least once every 10 years after June 30, 2000 2012.

SUMMARY

This bill is reported out by the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government and updates dates in statute for the State Government Evaluation Act review agencies under the jurisdiction of joint standing committees pursuant to Public Law 2013, chapter 307, section 9. It also updates the date by which the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government matters must review the provisions and effects of the State Government Evaluation Act.

The committee has not taken a position on the substance of the bill and by reporting this bill out the committee is not suggesting and does not intend to suggest that it agrees or disagrees with any aspect of this bill. The committee is reporting the bill out for the sole purpose of turning the draft into a printed bill that can be referred to the committee for an appropriate public hearing and subsequent processing in the normal course. The committee is taking this action to ensure clarity and transparency in the legislative review of this bill.
