2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§92 is enacted to read:
3 4 5	92. Bags for returnable containers. Sales of plastic bags used to sort, store and transport returnable beverage containers by local redemption centers licensed under Title 32, section 1871-A.
