2	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1411, as enacted by PL 2007, c. 251, §1, is repealed.
3	Sec. 2. Secretary of State to issue conforming licenses and identification
4	cards. The Secretary of State shall issue driver's licenses and nondriver identification
5	cards that conform to the federal REAL ID Act of 2005, enacted as part of the Emergency
6	Supplemental Appropriations Act for Defense, the Global War on Terror, and Tsunami
7	Relief, 2005, Public Law 109-13.
8	SUMMARY
9	This bill repeals the law that prohibits the State from participating in the federal
10	REAL ID Act of 2005 and the Secretary of State from changing the procedures for
11	applying for a driver's license or nondriver identification card in a manner to conform to
12	the federal REAL ID Act of 2005. It directs the Secretary of State to issue driver's
13	licenses and nondriver identification cards that conform to the federal REAL ID Act of
