COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 95, L.D. 315, Bill, “An Act Relating to the Status of a Private Investigator as an Independent Contractor ”

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph F in subparagraph (45) in the 2nd line (page 6, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "if" and inserting the following: 'as long as that employment is not subject to federal unemployment tax and'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment clarifies that in order to be excepted from the definition of "employment" in the Employment Security Law a private investigator may not be subject to coverage under the Federal Unemployment Tax Act.
