An Act To Amend the Laws Governing Competitive Bidding for School Construction and Repair

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1743-A, as amended by PL 1989, c. 700, Pt. A, §17, is further
amended to read:

4 §1743-A. Competitive bids; advertisement

5 Any contract for the construction, major alteration or repair of school buildings involving a total cost in excess of \$100,000 \$250,000, except contracts for professional, 6 7 architectural and engineering services, shall must be awarded by competitive bids. The 8 school district directors, school committee, building committee or whatever agency has responsibility for the construction, major alteration or repair shall, after consultation with 9 the Director of the Bureau of Public Improvements, seek sealed proposals. Sealed 10 proposals shall must be addressed to the responsible agency and shall must remain sealed 11 until publicly opened in the presence of the responsible agency or a committee thereof at 12 such time as the responsible agency may direct. Competitive bids may be waived in 13 individual cases involving unusual circumstances with the written approval of the 14 15 Director of the Bureau of Public Improvements and the Commissioner of Education.

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SUMMARY

17 The bill changes the minimum amount of the cost of school construction, major 18 alteration or repair requiring a competitive bid from over \$100,000 to over \$250,000.
