1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2117, as enacted by PL 2009, c. 223, §1, is repealed.
3 4	<b>Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §2117-A, sub-§3,</b> ¶ <b>C,</b> as enacted by PL 2009, c. 605, §1, is amended to read:
5	C. Any state, county or municipal law enforcement agency when providing public
6	safety, conducting criminal investigations and ensuring compliance with local, state
7	and federal laws. For purposes of this paragraph, "providing for public safety"
8	includes the enforcement of any state, county or municipal motor vehicle violations.
9	For purposes of this paragraph, an automated license plate recognition system may
10	use only information entered by a law enforcement officer as defined by Title 17-A,
11	section 2, subsection 17 and based on specific and articulable facts of a concern for
12	safety, wrongdoing or a criminal investigation or pursuant to a civil order or records
13	from the National Crime Information Center database or an official published law
14	enforcement bulletin.
