17 18	2. One representative of the Maine Tourism Commission selected by the Department of Economic and Community Development;
19 20	3. One person from each tourism region selected by the Department of Economic and Community Development, Office of Tourism;
21 22	4. One marketing director from the department, selected by the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife;
23 24	5. The Director of the Office of Tourism within the Department of Economic and Community Development; and
25 26	6. One nonresident sportsman selected by a statewide sportsmen's organization; and be it further
27	Sec. 3. Duties. Resolved: That the task force under section 1 shall:
28	1. Review the numbers of nonresident hunters over the last 5 years;
29	2. Review national trends regarding nonresident hunters over the last 5 years; and
30 31	3. Develop recommendations to increase the numbers of nonresident hunters in the future; and be it further'

1	SUMMARY
2	The bill required that an unspecified number of guides and outfitters be invited to
3	participate in the task force. This amendment specifies that an organization identified by
4	the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife is invited to select 3 guides and 3
5	outfitters for the task force. It clarifies that the Department of Economic and Community
6	Development shall select one representative from the Maine Tourism Commission, and it
7	adds the Director of the Office of Tourism to the membership of the task force. This
8	amendment also adds to the duties of the task force the examination of national trends
9	regarding nonresident hunters over the last 5 years.
