## An Act To Extend the Time by Which Certified Plans for a Subdivision Must Be Filed

### 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §685-B, sub-§6-A, ¶C, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 687, §2, is amended to read:

4 C. A copy of the certified plan must be filed within <del>30</del> <u>90</u> days of certification with 5 the State Tax Assessor and the appropriate registry of deeds in the county in which 6 the land is located.

### SUMMARY

8 This bill extends the time by which certified plans for a subdivision must be filed 9 from 30 days to 90 days.
