Resolve, To Authorize the Exchange of Certain Lands Owned by the State

- 1 **Preamble.** The Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 23 requires that real 2 estate held by the State for conservation or recreation purposes may not be reduced or its 3 uses substantially altered except on the vote of 2/3 of all members elected to each House.
- 4 **Whereas,** certain real estate authorized for conveyance by this resolve is under the 5 designations described in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 598-A; and

6 **Whereas,** the Director of the Bureau of Parks and Lands within the Department of 7 Conservation may sell or exchange lands or interests in lands with the approval of the 8 Legislature in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 6209 and Title 9 12, sections 1814, 1837 and 1851; now, therefore, be it

10 Sec. 1. Director of Bureau of Parks and Lands authorized, but not 11 directed, to convey certain interests in land in Oxford County. Resolved: 12 That the Director of the Bureau of Parks and Lands within the Department of Conservation may by quitclaim deed without covenant, for exchange of land or interests 13 in land of comparable market value, and on such other terms and conditions as the 14 director may direct, convey access rights by easement to Pingree Associates, Inc., in 15 connection with land in Township 5, Range 2, also known as Lincoln Plantation; 16 Township 4, Range 2, also known as Adamstown Township; Township 4, Range 1, also 17 known as Richardsontown Township; and Township C, all in Oxford County; and be it 18 19 further

20 Sec. 2. Director of Bureau of Parks and Lands authorized, but not 21 directed, to convey certain interests in land in Nashville Plantation in 22 Aroostook County. Resolved: That the Director of the Bureau of Parks and Lands 23 within the Department of Conservation may by quitclaim deed without covenant, for 24 exchange of land or interests in land of comparable market value, and on such other terms 25 and conditions as the director may direct, convey a parcel of land in Nashville Plantation, 26 in Aroostook County, to Pingree Associates, Inc.

SUMMARY

28 This resolve authorizes the Director of the Bureau of Parks and Lands within the 29 Department of Conservation, for exchange of land or interests in land of comparable 30 market value, to convey access rights by easement to Pingree Associates, Inc., in connection with land in Township 5, Range 2, also known as Lincoln Plantation; 31 Township 4, Range 2, also known as Adamstown Township; Township 4, Range 1, also 32 33 known as Richardsontown Township; and Township C, all in Oxford County. It also authorizes the director, for exchange of land or interests in land of comparable market 34 35 value, to convey a parcel of land in Nashville Plantation, in Aroostook County, to Pingree 36 Associates, Inc.
