COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 498, L.D. 1394, Bill, “An Act To Make Parents More Aware of Eating Disorders”

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, To Increase Awareness of Eating Disorders'

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. Eating disorder awareness. Resolved: That the Department of Education shall, through training programs it provides to school nurses and other school personnel, disseminate information about the seriousness of student eating disorders and the resources that are available to help schools identify, address and respond to eating disorders.'

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the minority report, replaces the bill with a resolve that directs the Department of Education, through training programs it provides to school nurses and other school personnel, to disseminate information about the seriousness of student eating disorders and the resources that are available to help schools identify, address and respond to eating disorders.
