1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §523, sub-\$2, as amended by PL 2007, c. 383, \$14, is
3	further amended to read:
4	2. Disabled veterans; special free license plates. The Secretary of State, on
5	application and upon evidence of payment of the excise tax required by Title 36, section
6	1482, shall issue a up to 2 registration certificate certificates and set up to 2 sets of special
7	designating plates to be used in lieu of regular registration plates for a vehicle vehicles
8	with a registered gross weight of not more than 10,000 pounds each to any 100% disabled
9	veteran when that application is accompanied by proof that the vehicles are owned by the
10	veteran and certification from the United States Veterans Administration or any branch of
11	the United States Armed Forces as to the veteran's permanent disability and receipt of
12	100% service-connected benefits. A Up to 2 disability placard is placards are issued in
13	addition to the disabled veteran registration plate plates at no fee.
14	These special designating plates must bear the words "Disabled Veteran," which indicate
15	that the vehicle is owned by a disabled veteran.
