It requires any unspent funds from the 2013-14 contract 7 with the now-closed Halcyon House emergency shelter in Skowhegan to be allocated to 8 the New Beginnings emergency shelter in Lewiston as soon as the Department of Health and Human Services determines that all financial obligations of Halcyon House have 9 10 been satisfied.
