As most of you know, in addition to enforcing fish and game law, Maine's Game Wardens respond to snowmobile accidents and fresh water drowning, boating accidents and other outdoor calamities. They are also responsible for wilderness search and rescue operations. In the course of their work, Game Wardens saw the need for victims and victims' families to receive dedicated emotional and spiritual support during such crises. It was the Wardens, therefore, who created the position of chaplain so as to better serve the citizens of Maine. Thus, in my work throughout the state and my presence in this chamber this morning, I do no more and no less than to embody the kindness, compassion, and vision of these extraordinary law enforcement officers. I am proud to share their uniform and to represent them before you today. Before I begin my prayer, I'd also like to extend a particular appreciation to those of you who may not court yourselves believers or churchgoers. Your acceptance of my presence in your chamber bespeaks tolerance and generosity. Thank you for having me. Join me as you will in the spirit of prayer.
