Joint Orders
(1-1) The following Joint Order: H.P. 1 ORDERED, the Senate concurring, that the Speaker of the House is authorized, at the Speaker's discretion, to permit radio or television in the Hall of the House of Representatives during joint conventions.
Comes from the House, READ and PASSED .
(1-2) The following Joint Order: H.P. 2 ORDERED, the Senate concurring, that there be prepared by the Legislative Information Office, under the direction of the Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House, after adjournment of the present session, a compilation of all the Bills and Resolves considered by both branches of the Legislature, showing the history and final disposition of each Bill and Resolve.
Comes from the House, READ and PASSED .
(1-3) The following Joint Order: H.P. 4 ORDERED, the Senate concurring, that, in accordance with the Constitution of Maine, Article IV, Part Third, Section 1-A, the Apportionment Commission is established to develop in accordance with the requirements of the Constitution of Maine a plan for apportioning the House of Representatives, the Senate or both. In accordance with the Constitution of Maine, Article IX Section 24, the Apportionment Commission shall review the existing congressional districts and as necessary, develop a plan to reapportion the State into congressional districts. In accordance with the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 25, the Apportionment Commission shall review the existing county commissioner districts and, as necessary, develop a plan to reapportion those districts in each county.
